Lloyd Aaron Quimby, age 42, passed away unexpectedly on Monday, December 18, 2023. Aaron was born in Coldwater, MI, on December 12, 1981, the youngest child of Lloyd and Nila (Golliver) Quimby. 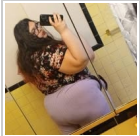
