Ann Napolitan, age 90, previously from Taylor, MI, most recently of Saline, MI passed away peacefully on Friday, March 8, 2024 at Cambrian Memory Care in Tecumseh, MI.

She was born August 24, 1933 in Kirkcaldy, Fife, Scotland to the late Peter Givens and Anne (Rourke) Givens. On April 4, 1959 she married the late Louis P. Napolitan.

Ann worked as a Secretary at Burton Abstract & Title Company in Detroit, MI before having children, after which she was a stay at home mom and grandmother. Throughout her life, Ann enjoyed working in her gardens, canning her vegetables, and spending time with her children and grandchildren.

Some of her favorite pastimes were taking trips with family to Lake Michigan - in Saugatuck and Ludington areas, as well as regular visits to Frankenmuth.

Ann was a Breast Cancer Survivor, beating the disease in the early 2000's.
