Barbara Sue Teeple Hoover passed at home in Ann Arbor Michigan after a long courageous battle with cancer surrounded by her family.

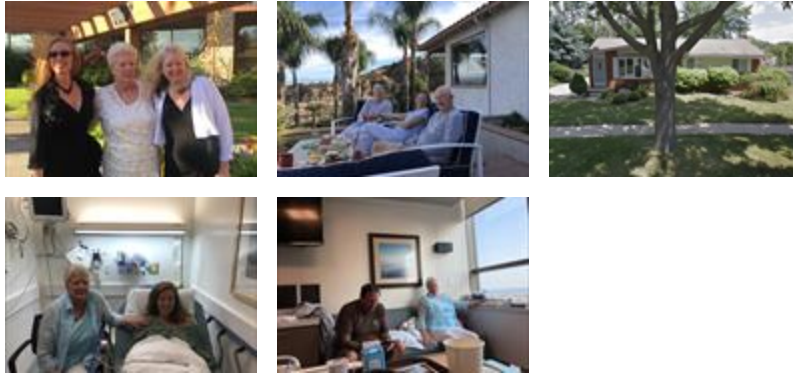
Sue was preceded in death by her parents, Muriel and Ross Teeple, her brothers, Ross and Eddie and a niece Beth.
