Beatrice "Bea" Haeussler, 85, died in her home, surrounded by loving family, following a brief illness, on Saturday, April 13, 2019. She was born on December 8, 1933 in Leoni, MI to the late Lawrence and Josephine (Stapish) Fowler. She grew up in Chelsea, MI, and graduated from Chelsea High School in 1952.
