Beth Wurmlinger Schmidt, age 61, of Ypsilanti, Michigan passed away peacefully on Monday, September 2, 2024, with family at her side.

Beth is survived by her husband of 37 years, Richard Schmidt; two daughters, Danielle Schmidt and Natalie Schmidt; her mother, Carol Wurmlinger; two brothers, Mark (Lisa) Wurmlinger and Mike Wurmlinger; and many nieces, nephews and other extended family.

Beth grew up in Jackson, MI and attended Northwest High School where she was an outstanding student. She loved sports and played Basketball, Volleyball, and Softball for the Mounties. Beth graduated from the University of Michigan with a degree in Nuclear Engineering, and later received a Juris Doctor degree from Duquesne University in Pittsburgh, PA. Beth worked as a nuclear engineer at Westinghouse Electric Company and later as a licensing engineer at Maine Yankee Atomic Power company before leaving her professional career to be a stay-at-home mother.

Beth had many interests including being an avid reader and was a member of various book clubs. She also enjoyed scrapbooking and documented all her daughter's early year memories in volumes of scrapbooks. Beth had a passion for quilting and worked with many of her friends to create dozens of quilts of all sizes and shapes. On any given Saturday she would be laser

focused on rooting on her U of M wolverines football team.

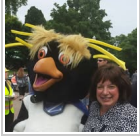
