April 11, 1937 - July 30, 2020

Beverly Ann (Daniels) Miller, 83, of Saline, Michigan passed away peacefully on Thursday, July 30, 2020 with her family by her side. 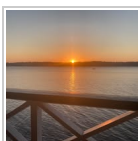
