Christopher John Fattori, age 58, passed away peacefully on Monday, August 25, 2025, at Trinity Health Hospital in Ann Arbor, surrounded by his loving family.

Born on September 9, 1966, in Ann Arbor, Michigan, Chris was a beloved son, brother, uncle, and friend. 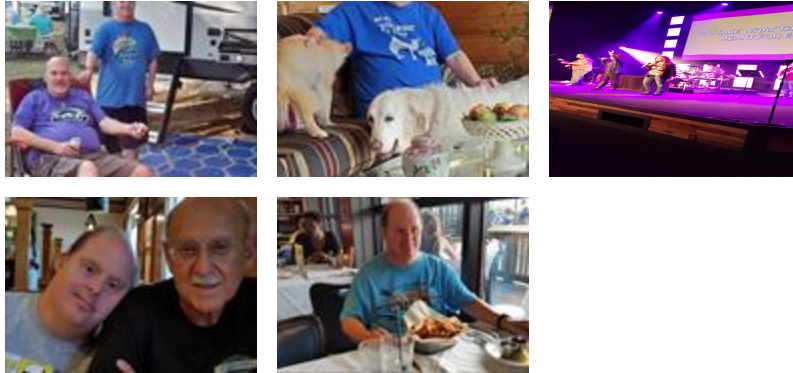

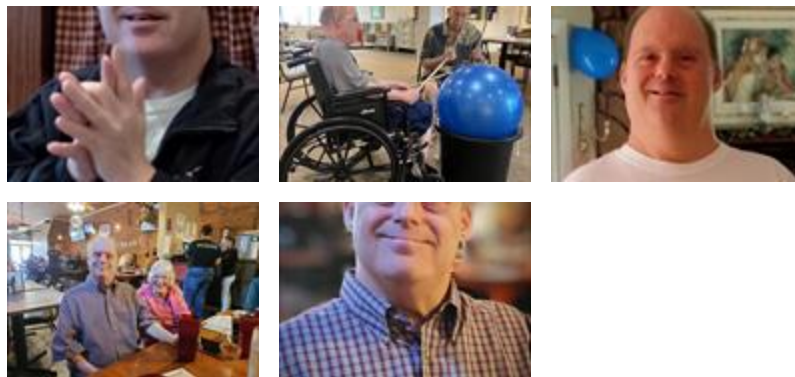
