He sang in the choir and also participated in the Parish Leadership Team. Clarke also sang in Measure 4 Measure, in Ann Arbor, Michigan. Clarke loved Lake Michigan and loved to travel the world.

Clarke is survived by his husband Daniel McGraw; two brothers, Bruce Flewelling, of Dexter Michigan, and Doug (Gerri) Flewelling of Colorado

Springs, Colorado; Dan's daughter, Lori (Joel) Shope; grandson, Jesse (Cassidy) Drouillard; and many nieces, nephews, and great nieces and nephews.

Along with his parents, Clarke is also preceded in death by a sister, Barbra Flewelling, of Petoskey, Michigan.

Family will receive friends on Saturday, October 12, 2024 at 12:00 P.M., with a Memorial Service being held at 1:00 p.m., at Holy Faith Church (6299 Ann Arbor- Saline Road Saline, Michigan).
