Age 95, passed away Tuesday, December 17, 2013 at the Saline Evangelical Home. She was born July 5, 1918 in Lodi Twp, MI, the daughter of John and Laura (Weidmayer) Wolfe. On Nov. 28, 1940 at the home of her parents, she married Leon K. Schaible, and he preceded her in death on Jan. 30, 1977.
