



Frances Rose Paulukewicz

May 24, 1921 - December 24, 2021

Frances Rose Paulukewicz, age 100, born Frances Kabalka, May 24, 1921, in Wilkes-Barre, Pennsylvania, passed away Friday, December 24, 2021 in Saline, Michigan. She married Michael Paulukewicz on April 2, 1946 at Transfiguration Church in Detroit, and he pre-deceased her in 2016. She was lovingly called “Auntie”, and was a special family member to her nieces and nephews: Karen (Ray) Berg, Tom (Nancy) Kopinski, Don (Ann) Kopinski, Jim (Susan) Kopinski, Mary Brown, Connie Bartlo, Mary (Dan) Evans, David Pawl, and Mark (Sandy) Pawl. She was the daughter of the late Frank Kabalka and Mary Olejarczyk. Sister to the late Connie Kocylowski, and brothers Leo, Anthony and Stanley. She passed away peacefully with her great-niece Michelle Lazar at her side.

Frances grew up in Wilkes-Barre, Pennsylvania, and moved to Detroit in 1941. She met Michael and they established their home in Detroit, and were active parishioners in St. Louis the King Catholic Church in Detroit until 2009, when they relocated to Saline and resided in the Brecon Village retirement community. She was spry and active up to her last days.

Cremation has occurred. Visitation will take place on Monday, January 10, 2022 from 9:30 AM to 10:30 AM at St. Andrew the Apostle Catholic Church (910 Austin Drive, Saline, MI 48176), followed by a Mass of Christian Burial at 10:30 AM. Reverend Fr. John Linden as Celebrant. Due to an increase in
