March 7, 1947 - January 2, 2025

Gerald “Jerry” Austin, age 77, of Saline, Michigan passed away peacefully at Hospice Home of Lenawee on Thursday, January 2, 2025 in the arms of his wife and surrounded by his four children. Jerry was born March 7, 1947 to Hugh and Della (Teachout) Austin and grew up on the Austin Apple Orchard in Saline. On August 2, 1974 he married Jan Cochrane and became “Guy-Daddy” to her two boys. They later welcomed two daughters to complete their family of six. Jerry was a very proud veteran of the United States Navy. He worked for the City of Saline for over 35 years and retired from his position of Superintendent of Water Production and Pollution Control in 2002. Jerry was an avid bowler and a 2002 inductee of the Ann Arbor Bowling Association Hall of Fame. He enjoyed camping trips with his family, singing in the church choir, floating in the pool while singing ridiculous songs he made up, and being his grandkids’ number one fan at all of their sporting events. 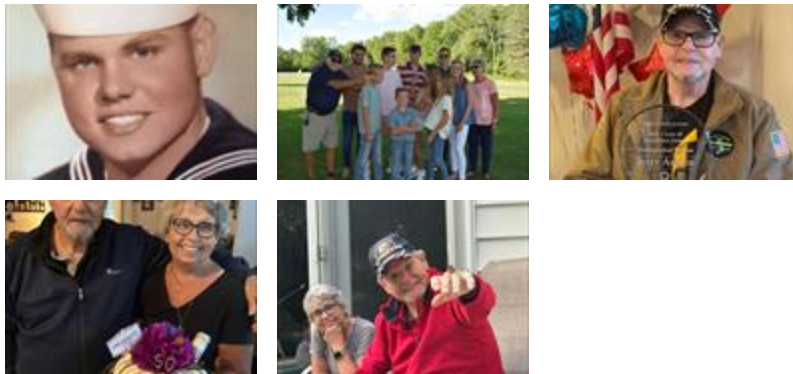
