Gertrud A. Klager, better known as Gerti, was born in Lollar, Germany on May 8, 1929. She came to the United States with her husband PFC. William James and they settled in Saline, MI. William James preceded her in death December 1960. Gerti then moved to Bridgewater, MI with her second husband Lloyd S. Klager, who also preceded her in death February 1969. Gerti was one of 5 sisters, late Margarta of Maryland, late Hedwig of Minnesota, Irene of Germany and Irmgard of Australia. Gerti is also survived by her three children, Mary (late Vic) Izzo, Ronald (Kathy) James and Trudy (Russell) San Nicolas; 6 grandchildren and 9 great-grandchildren. Gerti was a longtime member of St. John's Lutheran Church in Bridgewater, MI.
