



Glenn A. Meske

May 23, 1932 - May 10, 2014

Age 81, passed away on Saturday, May 10, 2014 at the Brookdale Place of Ann Arbor. He was born May 23, 1932 in Alpena, MI, the son of Paul and Marie (Kornack) Meske. On October 19, 1956 he married Margaret A. Rowe and she preceded him in death on November 5, 1987.
