Heather Lynn Feldkamp 47, of Saline, Michigan passed away on Wednesday, November 25, 2020 after a long hard-fought battle with cancer. Heather was born December 16, 1972 to Linda (Wiedmeyer) Hartmann, she was later adopted by James Reuben Hartmann who preceded her in death. Heather is also preceded by her grandparents Emerson and Alice Wiedmeyer, Douglas and Irene Kennedy and Mary Pickett.

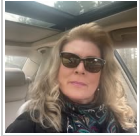
