Herbert Woodall Ford Jr, age 95, passed away on Friday, June 28, 2019 at the home of his daughter. He was born on June 15, 1924 in Bowling Green, Ohio. He was the son of Herbert Woodall Ford Sr. and Jacinth (McNutt) Ford. Herbert married his beloved wife Roselyn (Nassar) Ford on September 7, 1952 in the Orthodox Church and they later attended the Methodist Church. They went on to enjoy 65 years of marriage.
