Hilda Johanna Tormanen (fondly remembered as Hilda Jo or Jo), age 93 passed away Saturday, June 22, 2019 at Gilbert Residence, Ypsilanti, Michigan. She was born in Ithaca, New York on June 1, 1926, the daughter of Henry and Johanna (Oja) Koistinen. On December 2, 1950 she married Arnold H. Tormanen and he preceded her in death on June 30, 1978. Hilda worked as a secretary for Maricopa County in Phoenix Arizona for seven years.
