Jo Anne Roehm of Tecumseh, MI went to be with her Savior on Thursday, October 28, 2021. Jo Anne was born on November 16, 1965, the youngest of four children to John and Margaret (Sliker) Marion in Ann Arbor, MI. On April 28, 1990, she married Ronald Roehm in Saline, MI. and he survives.
