John "J.B." Moranville, age 72, of Granada Hills CA, died unexpectedly on October 1st, 2016 while on location in Vancouver BC. He was born September 17th, 1944 in St. Genevieve MO, the son of the late Jack and Kate (Klein) Moranville. J.B. enjoyed a very successful career in the movie and television industry. As a veteran TV Producer, his long list of credits includes the shows Family Feud, General Hospital, Dynasty, MacGyver, Profit, Pacific Blue, and Cult, among many others. He won several Telly, Aurora, and Davey awards in 2006 for the documentary TV show Goin' Back. He was most recently in Vancouver working on the upcoming series Riverdale. J.B. loved life, loved his family, cherished good friends -- and adored an audience. He "never let the truth stand in the way of a good story"!! He will be forever remembered by those whose lives he touched. J.B. is survived by a daughter, Lisa (Damian) Robertiello, sons Douglas and Mason Moranville, sisters Nanette Cooper and Cathy (Dan) Yoder, and many nieces and nephews. In addition to his wife Kimberly, he was preceded in death by his parents and brother Bob. Cremation has taken place.
