Julia P. Klein, 62, of Ypsilanti, Michigan passed away in her home on Sunday, May 15, 2022. Julia was born on May 16, 1959 to the late Michael Szurgyi and Julia Szurgyi (Erdosi). She is survived by her three children: Amanda (Ryan) Paul, Jonathon Klein, and Corina Klein, as well as the father of her children, John Klein. 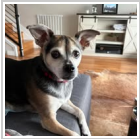
