Kevin Craig Limberg passed away on Saturday, June 28, 2025, at the age of 66. He was deeply loved and will be profoundly missed.

Kevin lived with unwavering integrity and an independent spirit. A master mechanic with a deep reverence for BMW and Triumph motorcycles, he was often called a motorcycle whisperer. His skilled hands and curious mind also shaped stone and brick, built stages and his own home, and took on countless trades. His craftsmanship and tireless work ethic were evident in all he did. He was a born storyteller—quick with a joke, generous with his attention, and deeply present in conversation. Kevin’s love of music ran wide and deep, from the blues and country to rock and jazz. He was passionate about racing, especially at the Milan Dragway, and always enjoyed a good game. Animals brought him joy and companionship, especially his cat, who shared his wild, free-spirited nature.

Kevin had a lifelong curiosity about the world and a special affection for the local history of Southeast Michigan. He often spoke with reverence about friends he had lost, honoring them through story and memory with great affection and respect.

He is preceded in death by his mother, Mary Lee Blackmon, and his father, Kenneth Limberg. He is survived by his sister, Gwen Daniels; his nieces, Aislinn Simmons and Emily Law; his nephew, Elijah Shephard Church; their families; and the friends who shared in his journey.

Kevin’s spirit lives on in the hum of a finely tuned engine, in laughter sparked

by an off-color joke, in stories told around a fire, and in music played from the heart. You'll find him wherever fairness, freedom, and a little rebellion still thrive—especially on the open road.
