Leonard Michael Wanat, age 76, passed away on Friday, September 17, 2021 at the St. Joseph Mercy Hospital. Leonard was born on November 1, 1944 in Gary, Indiana, the son of Michael J. and Stella (Jendrzejewski) Wanat. On June 3, 1967 in Gary, Indiana, he married Annette Gurauskas and she survives. 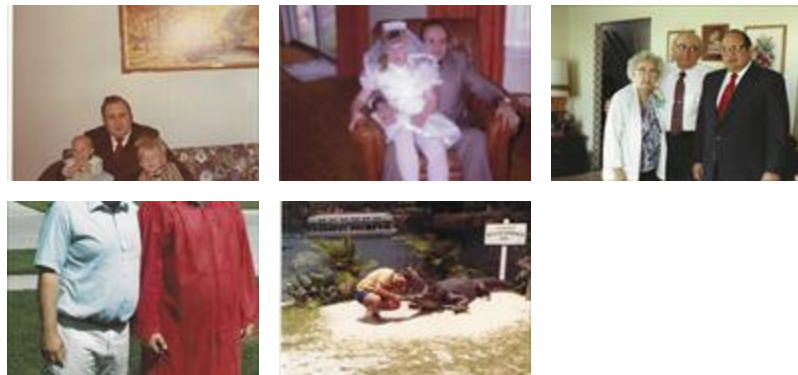

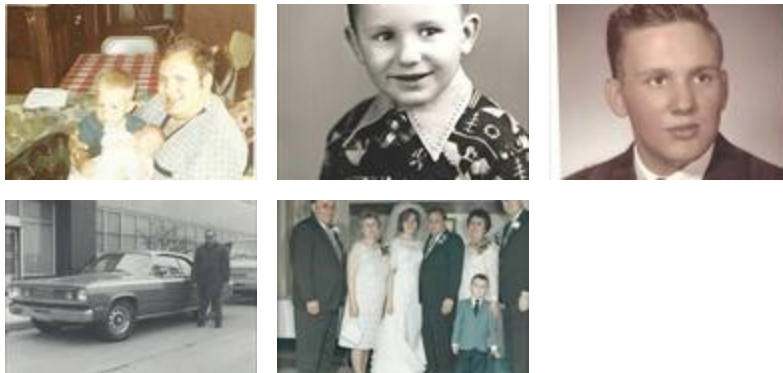
