



Lorna Grace Frey

December 4, 1924 - February 9, 2015

Age 90, passed away on Monday, February 9, 2015 at the St. Joseph Mercy Hospital. She was born December 4, 1924 in Detroit, MI, the daughter of Herman and Othillie (Busch) Schubert. On November 23, 1946 she married Harvey Edward Frey of Clinton, MI and he preceded her in death on July 5, 1992. Lorna was a devout Christian and member of Trinity Lutheran Church in Saline for nearly 60 years. Her early career included various secretarial positions in Detroit. In the early 1960s she began working for Saline Area Schools and after retiring remained close to many SAS friends. 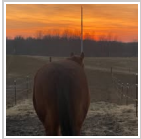
