Margaret Ann Schwingel, more affectionately known as Peggy, age 91, of Saline, Michigan went on to be with the Lord, Friday, July 12, 2024, with her husband of almost 69 years, her son and all her grandchildren by her side. Peggy was born September 25, 1932, to the late Erwin E. Wise and Edith L. (Neu) Wise on the family farm on Lent Hill in Cohocton, NY. On her birthday in 1955, she married Richard A. Schwingel who survives her. moved to Saline, Michigan to be closer to their son and grandchildren and where she continued many of her passions.
