Markus Alexander Guess, age 55, passed away at his home in Ypsilanti, Michigan on Friday, May 31, 2024. Markus was born on September 4, 1968 in Eloise (Westland), Michigan, to the late Robert Lee Guess Sr. and the late Delores June (Hardwick) Guess.

Markus and his family grew up in Inkster, Michigan where he attended the Westwood School District. He graduated from Robichaud High School, Class of 1986.
