



Mr. Meibai Meng

June 25, 1931 - June 9, 2024

Meibai Meng, aged 92, departed peacefully on Sunday, June 9, 2024 at Michigan Medicine Hospital following an unforeseen fall on June 5, 2024. His final hours were spent in tranquility, comforted by the presence of his devoted wife and son.

Meibai leaves behind a loving family: his cherished wife of 62 years, Peining; his children, Fan Meng and Peng Meng; and his three adored grandchildren, Emilee Meng, Ethyn Meng, and Hantao Yang.

Born in Ningbo, Zhejiang Province, China on June 25, 1931, to parents Jin Meng and Yecheng Wang, Meibai embarked on a journey of resilience and determination. He graduated from Qingdao Medical School, Shandong, China in 1957, and pursued further training in pathology, specializing in dermatology. His dedication led him to a distinguished career in China and retired from the Guangdong Provincial People's Hospital in 1995.

Meibai's life was a testament to his strength and perseverance. Despite losing his father at the tender age of 8 and living through the Second World War, the Chinese Civil War, and a period of relentless social and political upheaval, he remained steadfast. His career flourished in the late seventies when China embarked on a new path, and he became a renowned expert in his field. Collaborating with colleagues, he contributed to numerous publications and authored several books.

Throughout the trials and triumphs, Meibai remained a pillar of love and support for his family. Since 2011, he had been residing in Saline with his son and grandchildren, cherishing the serene and relaxing environment.
