Milica Bogi, age 72, of Ann Arbor passed away unexpectedly in her home on Monday, December 4th, 2023. She was born January 27, 1951 in Mojsinje, Serbia the daughter of Bosco and Danica Glisovic. In 1971 she moved to the United States. Milicia married John Paul Bogi Jr. on June 27, 1982 in Monroe, MI, and he survives. Milicia graduated from Virginia Farrell Beauty academy. She was employed at the University of Michigan in Ann Arbor for 39 years until her retirement in 2011 where she was in the EWOC program and worked her way up to Maintenance Mechanic II. She and her husband loved to travel. They took many trips to Europe, went on cruises, and were a part of many senior bus trips. Milicia loved attending her grandson's sporting events, spending time with her family, cooking great meals for them, and was a wonderful baker. She was also a great gardener; she grew beautiful flowers and vegetables.

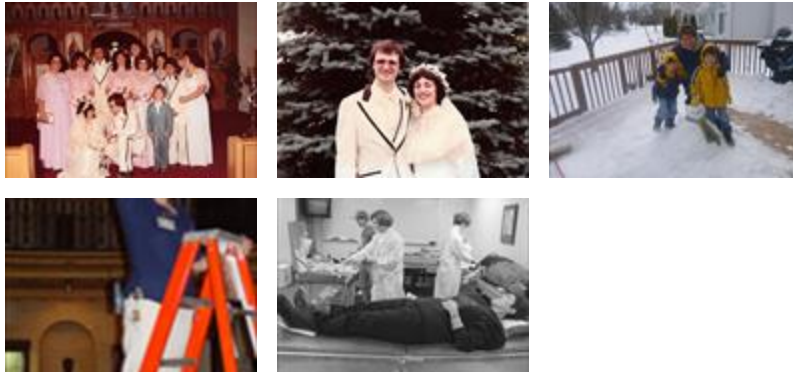
