She touched so many lives with her feisty spirit and outgoing personality. She was a bright light that lit up a room just by walking into it. Sadly, Nicole fought a long difficult battle with mental illness and addiction which eventually took her life.

Nicole leaves behind her beautiful children Jacob, Brennan, Tyler and Shyloh. She is also survived by three brothers, Sean Mitchell of Tecumseh, Michigan, Charles (Chas) Mitchell of Perry, Florida and Jared Dias of Chevy Chase, Maryland, three sisters Jennifer (Mitchell-Morris) of Oklahoma City, Oklahoma and Michayla and Maria (Mitchell) both of Perry, Florida.
