An MBA graduate from the University of South Dakota (USD) Vermillion, Orma worked as a financial manager in several capacities, to include, the Center for Disabilities at USD, South Dakota Public Broadcasting and as Deputy Superintendent of Finance at the Aberdeen School District. Her last job was at Ann Arbor School as Deputy Superintendent of Finance. She leaves behind, her husband, David Lapp, her niece Mandy Knight whom they adopted from England, Mandy's husband Chad Knight, seven sisters and one brother, numerous nieces, nephews, cousins and their beautiful Bichon dog, Tex. 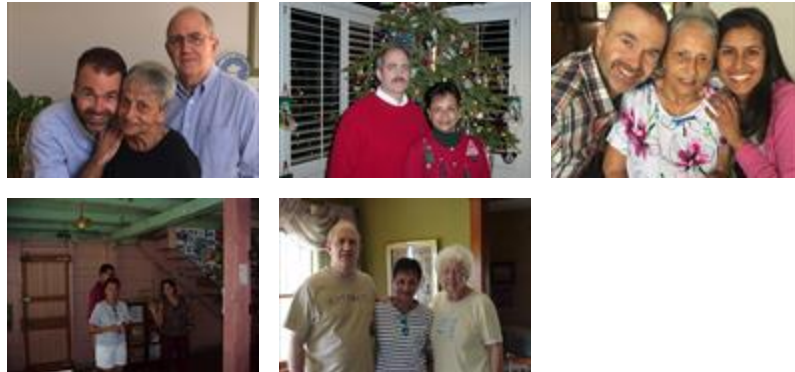
