Paul Allen Berneis died Friday, December 5, 2025 in Ann Arbor, Michigan. He was born in Detroit on June 27, 1948 to Hans and Regina (Fischhoff) Berneis.

Paul graduated from Loy Norrix High School in Kalamazoo and moved to Ann Arbor for university, where he met his wife of 53 years, Susan (Quinn) Berneis.
