Paul Alexander Schukow, age 79 of Saline, passed away the evening of Saturday, November 30, 2024, at Select Specialty Hospital, Ann Arbor.

Paul was born July 6, 1945, in Friedberg, Germany to the late Alexander P. and Paranka M. (Charkenyez) Schukow. Paul graduated from Saline High School in 1963 and went on to earn his associate's degree in Electrical-Mechanical Engineering from Jackson Community College.
