



## Pauline D. Dieterle

October 26, 1924 - November 24, 2012

Pauline Doris (Hertler) Dieterle, 88, passed away Saturday, November 24, 2012 at the Saline Evangelical Home after a year-long battle with cancer. She was born October 26, 1924 in Saline Township to Carl and Frieda (Wahl) Hertler. On August 6, 1949, in Junction City, Kansas, she was united in marriage to Kenneth Owen Dieterle.
