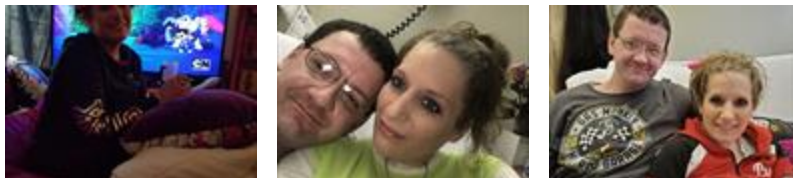


Pearl lived across the street from us in 1996 in Tecumseh MI. She visited our house often and played with our girls. Such a sweet girl. I will miss her! 💔😭
