



## Peggy Jean Walker

July 6, 1937 - July 7, 2015

Age 78, passed peacefully in her sleep on Tuesday, July 7, 2015 after an extended illness. Peggy was born on July 6, 1937 in Lapeer, MI. She grew up in Lapeer where she met her lifelong love, Dick Walker, in high school. They married in 1962 and after living in Ann Arbor for a few years, they moved to Saline to raise their family. Her love of animals helped create what became known as the "Walker Ranch". There was never a time when she didn't have a dog or a cat by her side, and often a barn full of horses and chickens. She had a place in her heart for them all, and instilled those values and many more in her children. Peggy is survived by the love of her life, Dick Walker; her children Andrea Springsteen (Ken Ross), Kim Lux (Paul), and Rick Walker (Katie Matson); her grandchildren Ian, Emma, Henry, Ryan, Nick, Mila, and Cash; her nephew Stephen Stimson; and friends and family from

Michigan to Texas and Oregon. She was preceded in death by her beloved sister, Ann Lynn, and mother Jean. They laughed a lot when they were together and the family laugh was unmistakable. It was contagious. She missed them terribly the years since they've been gone, and heaven is surely ringing with their laughter now.
