Roger L. Hamlin, age 76, of Saline, Michigan, passed away peacefully at his home on November 21, 2025.

Roger was born in Saline on November 10, 1949, to the late Glenn C. Hamlin and Virginia (Hatto) Hamlin. Roger was always a hard worker with a strong work ethic. He began working as a young boy on the family farm. His first paying job was at the Bridgewater Hatchery, where he cleaned crates for a nickel apiece. He drove a tow truck for Ted's Service throughout high school and continued until he enlisted in the United States Army. He was a paratrooper with the 173rd Airborne, serving in Vietnam from 1969–1970, where he earned the Air Medal and Bronze Star. He was very proud of his service. After returning home, Roger worked for Niethammer Trucking and American Broach. He owned two businesses: B&H Auto Body in Bridgewater and Wolverine Grinding, Inc., which he founded in 1989 and operated until his retirement in 2023. Roger enjoyed hunting, fishing, building hot rods, playing Euchre and Dominoes, and spending time with his family and friends. He is survived by his wife, Marie. His children, Nicole, Kyle, Kurt, & Keri. Their spouses, Eloy, Jillian, Tom, & Isaac. His grandchildren, Audra, Sophia, Ivy, & Levi. His beloved pets, Charlie & Millie.
