



Roger A. VanDoren

February 5, 1927 - February 4, 2017

At the age of 89, passed away on Saturday, February 4, 2017 at home surrounded by his family. Roger was born on February 5, 1927 in Ann Arbor, Michigan the son of Raymond W. VanDoren and Josephine I. Campbell. On August 7, 1948 in Milan, MI he married Dorothy Curd who survives him. Roger served in the Marines from 1944 to 1947 seeing combat action in the battle of Okinawa. At the conclusion of the war, he served in the military police in Japan until the end of his tour. He was proud to serve his country and proud to serve in the Marine Corp "Semper Paratus". Roger worked for Detroit Edison as a line clearance investigator for 38 years until his retirement. He was a lifetime member of the Newberry American Legion Post #74. Roger is survived by his wife of 68 years, Dorothy, and 4 of their children Raymond (Ruth) VanDoren of Manchester, Richard (Diane) VanDoren of Brooklyn, Jeffrey (Geraldine) VanDoren of Dexter, and Shanna Wykes of Saline; along with his grandchildren Jennifer (Luis) Duma, Roger VanDoren, Kason VanDoren, Stacey Wykes, Kyle Wykes and Dillon Wykes; great-grandchildren Ian Duma and Veida VanDoren and great-great grandchild Roman Duma. Wykes, and brother-in-law Morris Allred, along with his parents Raymond and Ellen VanDoren.
