



Roslyn K. McLean

June 20, 1946 - December 22, 2022

Roslyn Kay McLean, age 76, of Ypsilanti, Michigan passed away peacefully on Thursday, December 22, 2022 with her family and friends by her side. Roslyn was born June 20th, 1946 in Wyandotte, MI, to the late Ross E. McLean and Evelyn M. (Boie) McLean of Ypsilanti, MI. Roslyn grew up in Taylor Twp, Allen Park and Belleville, MI. She attended the Huron public schools, graduating in 1964 from Huron High School, Flat Rock, MI. Later, she attended the Virginia Farrell Beauty School, Livonia, MI where she received her license in cosmetology, and years later she taught hairdressing at the school. Roslyn worked at Gi Gi's Hair Salon, Dearborn Heights, MI for several years before it became Charles & Co. She retired from Charles & Co. in 2000 to care for her aging mother who passed away in 2002. In her teen years while attending the New Boston Methodist Church, Roslyn heard the gospel and received the LORD Jesus Christ as her personal Savior. Soon afterwards, her family became members of the Wayne Free Methodist Church, Wayne, MI. Roslyn and 3 of her siblings were very active in the church youth group, led by youth directors, Don and Jean Smith. This spiritual influence, in her life, led to the various ministries Roslyn served in throughout her lifetime: Teen Challenge, Expo 67, volunteer work at the Detroit Rescue Mission, Bible quiz coaching, Sunday School helper, choir member, and always a faithful soulwinner. Due to a very serious car accident, causing multiple physical disabilities, Roslyn moved back home to live with her parents in Ypsilanti. When physically able, she attended her parent's home church, York Baptist

Church, Milan, MI. After the passing of her parents, Roslyn eventually moved to Clark East Towers of Ypsilanti till her passing. During her last 11 years, Roslyn sought ministering to others via Facebook to those she met online. Roslyn attended via the internet, Ann Arbor Baptist Church, Ann Arbor, MI. Roslyn is survived by sibling Karen (Paul) Basala, Mary (Dave) Oswald, David (Kathy) McLean, Owen Douglas (Vicki) McLean, Pamela (Chuck) Haskell and many nieces and nephews. She is preceded in death by her sister, Kathleen Joyce McLean and brother, Ross Frederick McLean. Funeral services will be held on Thursday, December 29, 2022 at 11:00 A.M. at York Baptist Church, 11220 Stoney Creek Rd., Milan, MI 48160. Friends may join the family for a time of visitation that will take place from 10:00 A.M. until the time of service. Reverend David Grinnell and Reverend Johnathon Barber will be officiating the service. In lieu of flowers, memorial contributions may be made to York Baptist Church or Ann Arbor Baptist Church's mission work. Following the ceremony, a luncheon will be provided by York Baptist church for family and friends. Burial will take place in Michigan Memorial Cemetery in Flat Rock, MI and will be for family members only.
