Sandra Walter 55, of Ann Arbor, Michigan passed away peacefully on Saturday, February 18, 2023 surrounded by her loving family. She was born to Silvio and Carol Malinari on March 13, 1967 in Manhasset, New York. Ann Arbor has been her home for the last 23 years.
