Terron Devon Beitelshees, age 74, of Saline, passed away while surrounded by family on Sunday, June 25, 2023. He will be remembered as being a quiet and gentle man who was loved by many.

Terry grew up in Ypsilanti, MI. After high school graduation, he went on to attend Central Michigan University. Terry then began his career as a federal government employee until retirement in 2010.
