



Thomas Allan Burns

September 30, 1965 - February 19, 2016

Age 50, passed away on Friday, February 19, 2016 at his home. He was born September 30, 1965 in Flemington, NJ, the son of Allan F. and Asenath (Payne) Burns. On August 8, 1987 in Collegeville, PA, he married Joy Litka, and she survives. He graduated from Coatesville Area Senior High School in Coatesville, PA in 1983 and then from Bridgewater College in Bridgewater, VA, in 1987 with a double major in Physics and Computer Science. It was there he met the love of his life, Joy, to whom he had the privilege of being married for 28 years. He began his career in software development at Texas Instruments in Dallas, TX, but most recently worked for almost 16 years at MSCI, where he attained a title of Vice President. He had been an active member of Saline First United Methodist Church since moving to Michigan in the summer of 1993, leading Sunday School classes, playing handbells, and serving on numerous committees. He was an avid cyclist, handyman, video gamer, train enthusiast, and science fiction aficionado. He loved camping with his family, baking and breadmaking, and had a unparalleled wit.
