“ *Virgil was from Dava, Romania which was ruled by King David and after the Nazis occupied his land and he witnessed their brutality. The Russians beat the Nazis and occupied his homeland and installed a barbaric leader Nicole Ceausecu who repression of the folks there was legendary and was later shot by a firing squad. Virgil was an auditor for the province he lived in and went to Vienna on business for the State and defected. He made his way to Detroit and sought political asylum, and worked in a sausage factory and then later came to Ann Arbor in the early 70's and worked as a custodian for the University of Michigan. I met him there and he regaled me with stories of his youth in the Carpathian Mountains and the legend surrounding Vlad the Impaler.*

He was very intellectual and well read on geopolitics and economics and we spent hours talking about his homeland and was always curious about my life here. Despite living a spartan existence in Ann Arbor, He always emphasized he was free. I was proud to have him as a friend.*
