February 8, 1947 - September 1, 2023

Virgil Carl Rockwell, age 76, of Saline, Michigan scored his perfect 300 into the arms of God on Friday, September 1st, 2023. Virgil was born February 8th 1947, to the late Virgil A. and the late Vera M. (Opel) Rockwell. In November 1966 he married the late Ruth McIntire. On June 19th, 1977, he married Judith R. Levinson and she survives. Virgil is survived by his four children; Melissa Ann (Rockwell) Taylor, Renee Lynn (Rockwell) Dorr, and sons Matthew Jason and Richard Madison Rockwell. Virgil is also survived by five grandchildren; John Lewis and Samantha Ann Richards, Jacob Peterson and Amber Dorr, and Jaxsyn David Wilson. After completion of high school, Virgil enlisted for a short term in the Air Force. He worked as an autoworker at Ford Motor Company for ten and a half years. Virgil then worked thirty years for Goetzcraft Printers, Inc as a delivery driver and building janitor. He enjoyed bowling (where he met his wife Judy), fishing, watching westerns, reading, listening to gospel music, and driving on family outings. He was a member of The Church on Strayer in Maumee, Ohio for many years. Cremation has taken place. 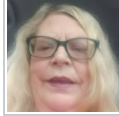
