Age 39, passed away on Monday, November 11, 2013 at his home. He was born February 2, 1974 in Phnom Penh, Cambodia. Vuthy was a long term associate at the University of Michigan Institute for Social Research and had worked for over 15 years as a Sr. Programmer Analyst. He was also the co-Founder and Chief Information Officer of Kermera Solutions, LLC, his IT and healthcare consulting company.
