Wesley Jay Exelby, age 85, passed away on Saturday, July 3, 2021 at his home in Saline. He was born on July 28, 1935 in Britton, Michigan, the son of the late Robert and Minerva (Brady) Exelby. On June 16, 1962 he married Rosemarie Weisenreder, and she preceded him in death on March 29, 1987. Wesley dedicated his life to CBES and his clients.
