March 1, 1941 - December 27, 2013

Age 72, passed away on December 27, 2013. He was born in Monroe, MI, the son of Jesse and Mabel (Schroeder) Fanning. Bill received his Bachelor's and Master's Degrees from EMU in Industrial Arts. He was an accomplished athlete at Ida High School and played football for 3 years at EMU where he was a member of the Kappa Phi Alpha Fraternity. He married Olivia (Sample) in 1964. Bill taught Industrial Arts and Building Trades in Wayne-Westland for 37½ years. He was a member of the First United Methodist Church in Ann Arbor. Bill was a talented craftsman, water colorist, avid reader, and golfer. He coached Little League Baseball for many years in Saline and was a supporter of all athletics, especially when family members were participants. Survivors include his wife; daughter, Shawn (Michael) LaRose; son, Grant (Andrea Paquin) Fanning; three grandchildren, William and Peter LaRose and Sophia Fanning; also sister Marilee Ball and brother Robert Fanning. He was preceded in death by his parents and brother, Richard Fanning.
